ELIGIBILITY

The **Connect, Collaborate, Celebrate Art Competition and Exhibition** is open to people 18+ living with disability, experiencing social isolation or at risk of marginalization.

1. Expression of Interest Application (**Form 1**) must be completed online or emailed to dcc@willoughby.nsw.gov.au or mailed to **Dougherty Community Centre, 7 Victor St, Chatswood NSW 2067**.
2. **Theme: Connect, Collaborate, Celebrate** – each artwork submission must reflect at least one of this competition's themes.
3. There is no entry fee for submitted artworks in this competition and exhibition.
4. There are three (3) prizes on offer for the **Connect, Collaborate and Celebrate: Art Competition and Exhibition 2023** totalling \$700 in vouchers. The judges' decision is final and there will be no appeals on these decisions.
5. Submissions may be not smaller than A4 and no larger than 100cm x 100cm.
6. A maximum of two (2) artworks in total may be submitted by each individual artist, one application per artwork.
7. Artworks must be flat – visual arts and graphic arts – no sculptures, models etc.
8. Each entry must be the original work of the artist suitably framed and **mounted with D-Rings** and clearly labelled with artist's name and title of the work.
9. The artist is responsible for ensuring that no relevant copyright laws are infringed.
10. A photo or scan of the submitted artwork will be exhibited on a digital platform by Willoughby City Council. Should a lockdown be imposed, these entries will be available to view on this website from 30 November 2023.
11. Photos or scans of the artwork submitted should be *2480x3508 pixels at 600dpi (recommended)* and in a well-lit environment if taken as a photo. Provide your name and your artwork name on the submitted file, e.g.: "Jan Brown - Connection.jpg"
12. **Artwork Submission (Form 2)** must be completed and attached to artwork entries when they are delivered. Works will not be accepted without a completed **Artwork Submission (Form 2)**.
13. The signed **Artwork Submission (Form 2)** is binding and listing information will only be taken from the **Artwork Submission (Form 2)**, not from the back of the artwork.
14. Entries with a completed Artwork Submission Form(s) must be delivered **Dougherty Community Centre, 7 Victor Street, Chatswood** between **10:30am – 4.30pm, Monday –Friday 13-17 November 2023**.
15. All transport and insurance costs to/from and during the exhibition must be met by the exhibitor. All care will be taken but no liability by **Connect, Collaborate and Celebrate: Art Competition and Exhibition 2023** will be accepted for loss or damage in transit, or whilst on exhibit.
16. Artworks cannot be removed before **Friday 15 December 2023** and must be collected on **Tuesday 19 December 2023 between 10:00am and 4:30pm**. Contact Event Coordinator - **02 9777 7804**, to discuss alternative arrangements and agree logistics.
17. Winner and 2 Highly Commended prizes will be announced at the **invitation only** morning tea to be held **11.00am Thursday, 30 November 2023** at **Dougherty Community Centre, 7 Victor Street, Chatswood**.
