- 1. The pecuniary interests and other matters to be disclosed in this return are prescribed by Schedule 1 of the *Model Code of Conduct* for Local Councils in NSW (the Model Code of Conduct).

#### **Important Information**

This information is being collected for the purpose of compliance with clause 4.21 of the Model Code of Conduct.

You must not lodge a return that you know or ought reasonably to know is false or misleading in a material particular (see clause 4.23 of the Model Code of Conduct). Complaints made about breaches of these requirements are to be referred to the Office of Local Government and may result in disciplinary action by the council, the Chief Executive of the Office of Local Government or the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal.

The information collected on this form will be kept by the Chief Executive Officer in a register of returns. The Chief Executive Officer is required to table all returns at a council meeting.

Information contained in returns made and lodged under clause 4.21 is to be made publicly available in accordance with the requirements of the Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009, the Government Information (Public Access) Regulations 2009 and any guidelines issued by the Information Commissioner.

You have an obligation to keep the information contained in this return up to date. If you become aware of a new interest that must be disclosed in this return, or an interest that you have previously failed to disclose, you must submit an updated return within three months of becoming aware of the previously undisclosed interest.

In accordance with section 6 of the Government Information (Public Access) Regulation 2018 (GIPA Act), the GIPA Act requires agencies make certain information publicly available, this includes the returns of the interests of councillors and designated persons (see clause 1(2)(a) of Schedule 1).

Section 6(4) of the GIPA Act requires agencies to "facilitate public access to open access information contained in a record by deleting matter from a copy of the record to be made publicly available, if inclusion of the matter would otherwise result in there being an overriding public interest against disclosure of the record, and it is practicable to delete the matter".

Clause 3 in the table in section 14 of the GIPA Act, lists as a consideration against disclosure the fact that information may reveal someone's personal information, or would contravene an information privacy principle under the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* (NSW) (PPIP Act).

An individual has a right to protect the privacy of their personal information. Given the amount of personal information that may be contained in the returns, special care should be taken to protect this right. Therefore, Council has decided that there is an overriding public interest against disclosure, and will be releasing an edited copy of the record (for example redacting the individual's signature or residential address) in accordance with section 6(4) of the GIPA Act.
