



WASTE MINIMISATION PLAN

Willoughby City Council has passed a motion to **remove single-use plastics from all Council operations.** Each year more than 8 million tonnes of plastic enters the oceans and over 90% are single use items. The motion was unanimously approved at the Council meeting on 13 August 2018. The external ban; including public events and markets held in Chatswood Mall will commence on 1 January 2019.
