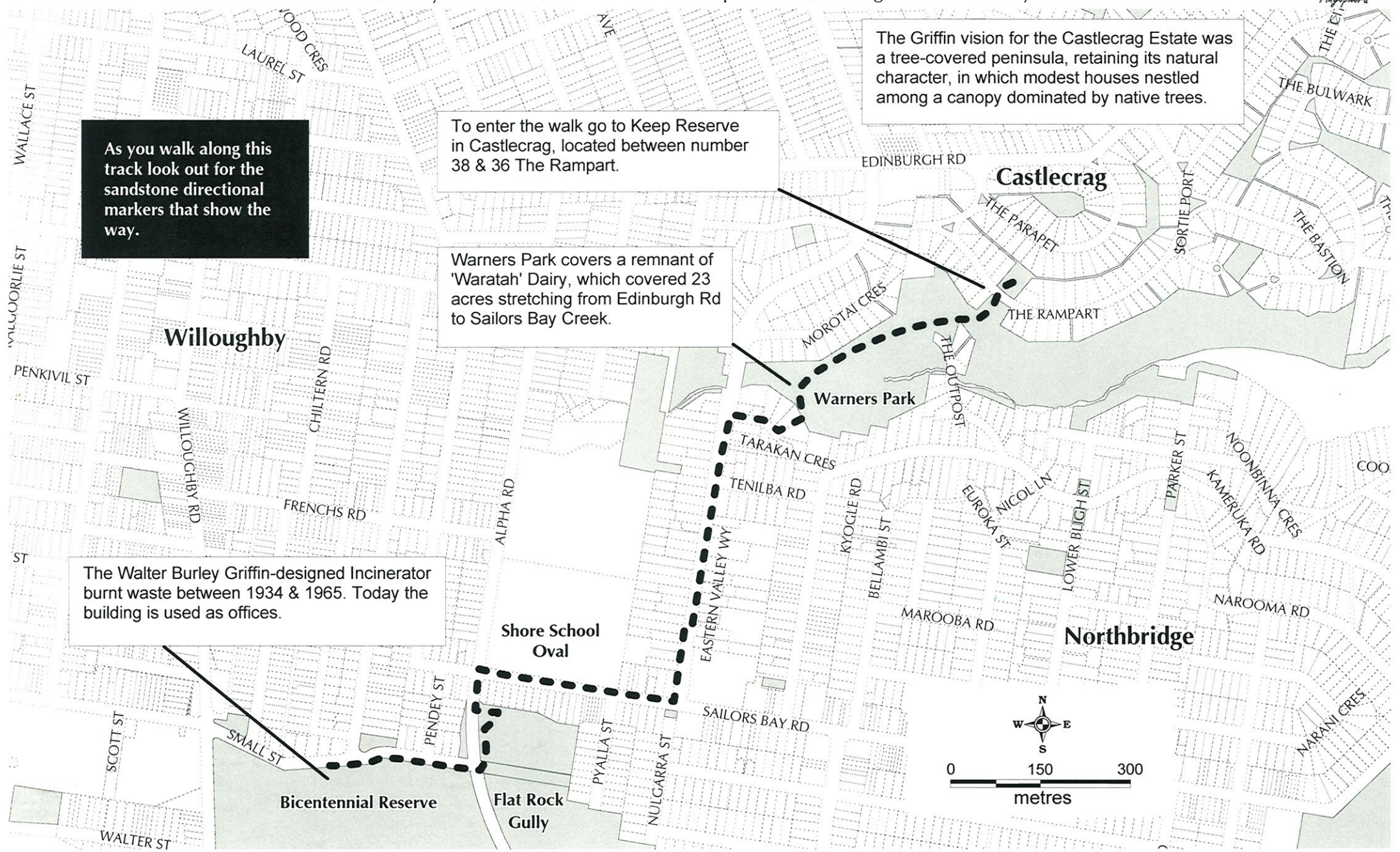




# THE GRIFFIN FEDERATION TRACK

The Griffin Federation Track traverses through bushland, parkland and suburbs, linking two important Walter Burley Griffin legacies: the Castlecrag Estate and the Willoughby Incinerator.  
Grade: easy - medium (bush track with steep sections) Length: 2km one way



The Griffin vision for the Castlecrag Estate was a tree-covered peninsula, retaining its natural character, in which modest houses nestled among a canopy dominated by native trees.

As you walk along this track look out for the sandstone directional markers that show the way.

To enter the walk go to Keep Reserve in Castlecrag, located between number 38 & 36 The Rampart.

Warners Park covers a remnant of 'Waratah' Dairy, which covered 23 acres stretching from Edinburgh Rd to Sailors Bay Creek.

The Walter Burley Griffin-designed Incinerator burnt waste between 1934 & 1965. Today the building is used as offices.
