Eastern Valley Way



Eastern Valley Way, Pacific Highway, Boundary St, Ashley St. The 277 service connects Castle Cove with Chatswood Transport Interchange via Boundary and Ashley Streets.

The walk follows local roads past attractive bushland along Castle Cove Drive, a waterfall off Eastern Valley Way and takes a cool green detour via Muston Park. Muston Park is named after William Thomas Muston, the original owner of the land and Mayor of Willoughby in 1890. The Park is located at the transition between Hawkesbury Sandstone and Wianamatta Shale soils and would once have supported Blue Gum High Forest. Eastern water dragons are often seen around here, and in summer you may spot ducklings on Scott's Creek. Both Muston Park and Beauchamp Park (optional detour) contain public toilets, picnic tables and small playground areas.
