Join us for an outing around Sydney

At Home with Willoughby's Social Outing Bus Program aims to provide the community with a range of varied and interesting experiences as well as opportunities for social engagement. Come along and meet new friends, travel to interesting locations around Greater Sydney, and enjoy lunch within an inclusive and supportive environment.

What you need to know

The basic cost for each bus trip is \$18.50, which is invoiced at the end of the month. At cafés and restaurants, clients order and pay from the menu at the venue.

Trips operate on the first, third and fourth Wednesdays of the month. The trip on the fourth Wednesday of the month is shorter and is suitable for clients with mobility difficulties or who may be unable to spend longer periods of time on the bus.

DEMENTIA AWARENESS & SUPPORT

Warning Signs of Dementia

The below are taken from Dementia Australia. If you are concerned that you or someone you know have some of the below symptoms then it is important to talk to your doctor as soon as you can – they can discuss treatments and strategies that may assist you.

- Recent memory loss that affects job skills forgetting things more often and not remembering them later.
- Difficulty performing familiar tasks eg preparing a meal, but forgetting to serve it.
- Problems with language forgetting simple words or substituting inappropriate words.
- Disorientation of time and place becoming lost in a once familiar environment.
- Poor or decreased judgement possibily becoming a risk to yourself or others when performing complex tasks like driving.
- Problems with abstract thinking.
- Misplacing things repeatedly putting things in inappropriate places.
- Changes in mood or behaviour rapid mood swings for no apparent reason.
- Significant changes in personality.
- Loss of initiative and motivation it is normal to tire of household chores and social obligations but a person with dementia may become very passive and require prompting to become involved.

The National Dementia Helpline is a good place to start if you have questions or are seeking further information about dementia, either before or after a dementia diagnosis.

SHOPPING SERVICES

All Aboard! The Tuesday Shopping Bus



The SHOPPING BUS will pick you up from your home and drop you off at the Spring Street entrance of Westfield Shopping Centre at 12 noon. You will have approximately 2 hours for shopping before the bus returns at 2pm to take you home. Cost \$8.30 for the return trip or \$5.70 one-way.

Companion Shopping

Individually assisted Companion Shopping services can be arranged for residents living in the Willoughby area who have low vision or a mobility issue that prevents them from using public transport or the shopping bus. This service can be utilised fortnightly, monthly or on an ad-hoc basis. Cost is \$21 for a 2 hour service.

Home Delivered Groceries

At Home with Willoughby can organise a home delivery of groceries through Coles or Woolworths Online Shopping. You will need to have a debit or credit card.

Our friendly volunteers will contact you by phone on Mondays and take your order. It will be processed through the internet and Coles or Woolworths will deliver your groceries to your door later in the week, generally on a Thursday. There is no cost from At Home with Willoughby for this service but Coles and Woolworths do charge a delivery fee dependant on the timeframe you choose for delivery. You can choose whether you prefer to receive groceries from Coles or Woolworths.

At Home with Willoughby Linen Service

The Linen Service provides freshly laundered sheets, pillowcases and towels to eligible clients living in the Willoughby local government area.

A team of caring volunteers visits your home each fortnight on a Tuesday morning to deliver the fresh linen and towels and to remake your bed. Used linen is collected and sent out to a commercial laundry for cleaning.

The cost of the service is \$14 per bed. Clients receive an invoice at the end of each month and direct debit can be set up for ease of payment.

Phone **1800 200 422.** If you are unsure or need assistance when calling My Aged Care, you can call our office on 9777 7824 and we are happy to support you with this process.

My Aged Care is the central hub for accessing all aged services. It is important that you call and get your Aged Care number early and before you are in need of help at home.

You may be able to access services that will support you to be able to remain living at home independently and with confidence for as long as you wish.

Seniors Rights Service

The Seniors Rights Service provides free legal advice, advocacy and information to seniors around issues relating to aged care. They offer advice on legal issues, and their advocates are able to listen to your concerns, assist you to lodge complaints with aged care providers, and help you to understand your rights and responsibilities whilst receiving aged care services.

You do not need to be currently receiving aged care services to contact the Seniors Rights Service. To be eligible you must be 65 or over, or 50 or over for Aborignal and Torres Strait Islanders.

Dangers of Heat Stroke

The summer of 2024 is forecast to be exceptionally hot, and it is important to adequately prepare to avoid heat stroke or heat exhaustion. Older people are less able to regulate their body temperature, and so are especially vulnerable to high temperatures causing heat related illnesses. Heat stoke or heat exhaustion can be deadly and cause organ failure.

Please discuss a heat plan with your doctor, especially if you normally have restricted fluids. Ensure you avoid sugary, alcoholic or caffeinated drinks, wear loose clothing, shade your home and use air conditioning. The Dougherty Community Centre is air conditioned and open to all seeking a cool space.
