

Introduction

Open Bite Printmakers Inc. are a Sydney-based printmaking collective whose mission is to facilitate, develop and educate in the field of printmaking. Originally formed in 1991, Open Bite take their name from an etching technique in which acid bites into exposed areas of a metal plate which, when inked, create dark irregular lines at the margins of the image and unpredictably toned areas elsewhere. The group's original logo of an open-mouthed shark, derived from a linocut by founding member and passionate printmaker, Ingrid Johnstone, fittingly captured the energy of the Open Bite printmakers' appetite for their chosen media.

They employ a diverse range of printmaking techniques including: embossing, etching, aquatint, screenprint, monotypes, mokuhanga (woodblock), collagraph, drypoint, linocut, solar plate intaglio, stencil, collage, hand-painting, fabric, stitching, watercolour, found objects for printing and 3D works. Meeting originally in members' homes, then in various Sydney locations including the Royal Art Society at Lavender Bay, like so many in current years, Open Bite printmakers are presently gathering online. With their inaugural show held at the Balmain Watchhouse in March 1992, the group now exhibit regularly around Australia and internationally.

To celebrate their 30th anniversary, the artists of Open Bite chose to spotlight RED - a colour that evokes a powerful emotional response, carries intense symbolic power, and is laden with cultural and social meanings.

Their print works explore the vibrancy of reds in the natural world, play with colour references in our language and celebrate this lively colour as a counterpoint to the bland and serious, the dark, ominous and fearful.














Cowell Building Maze









Polymer plate etching hand coloured 37.5 x 17cm, 2022




Merodon

Polymer plate etching & acrylic paint 29 x 20cm, 2022
















Etched linocut, 25 x 37cm, 2020














Comet in 2 Reds


